 - 3.1 Council File **13-1152-S1**: Hydraulic Fracturing / Fracking / Prohibition of Well Stimulation Activities. Review, discuss, and revise draft Community Impact Statement ("CIS") in support of fracking moratorium and requesting City Attorney to timely draft ordinance prohibiting fracking.
MOTION: The CIC shall approve the draft Letter concerning Council File 13-1152-S1.
 - 3.2 Council File **14-1062**: Vending and Camping in Public Parks / Prohibitions / Penalties for Violation / Ordinance Amendment. Review, discuss, and revise draft CIS in support of the amendment of Subdivision 3 of Subsection B of Los Angeles Municipal Code, which regulates commercial sales and services in parks, to prohibit unpermitted commercial vending. The proposed amendment however, should allow use of public parks for fitness or other wellness-related uses regardless of whether such use is a commercial activity.
MOTION: The CIC shall approve the draft Letter concerning Council File 14-1062.
 - 3.3 Council File **14-0163-S4**: Comprehensive City Sidewalk Repair Program / Regular Program for Improvements (Identify, Prioritize and Budget). Review, discuss, and revise draft CIS stating that DLANC supports a "fix and release" plan for the repair of damaged sidewalks and requests that it be provided an opportunity to provide input as to which sidewalks should take priority for repair.

 - 3.4 Council File **14-0223**: Imposing Living Wage / Hotel Employees / Hotels with 100 Rooms or more / Citywide Economic Impacts / Study and Public Input. Update on status of CF 14-0223. Review, discuss, and revise draft CIS.
