This correspondence is to convey a motion of support by the Board of Directors of the Downtown Los Angeles Neighborhood Council (“DLANC”) to re-approve and extend continued support for the Broadway streetscape improvements. At the May 14<sup>th</sup> board meeting, the motion was passed on the recommendation of DLANC’s Public Safety & Health committee meeting from May 1<sup>st</sup>.

The “trial run” build-out of street narrowing and pedestrian safety improvements and amenities will work to revitalize Broadway, increase pedestrian traffic, create a traffic calming effect and encourage outdoor dining and a decrease in traffic noise. The curb bump outs and cross walk improvements will prepare Broadway and downtown stakeholders for the forthcoming downtown streetcar.
