

GLC Agenda Items (10/10/16)

- 1) **CIS “Against Unless Amended”, CF No. 16-0425** (FilmLA, Incorporated / Construction and Development Projects / Downtown Los Angeles / Report on Impact)
 - a) **CF Summary:**
 - i) File open March 2, 2016, and referred to Entertainment and Facilities Committee. No action since then.
 - ii) The file proposes the City Council move to have City departments “report on how the various construction/development projects throughout Downtown Los Angeles impact filming in the City and what steps have been taken to minimize this impact,” and to request “FilmL.A., Inc. to report on the impact that various construction/development projects have on filming in the Downtown Los Angeles area and at or near other popular film locations throughout the City.”
 - b) **GLC Action:** 9/21/2016 to recommend **Motion** below; Yea (6), Nay (0), Abstain (0)
 - c) **Arguments for CF:**
 - i) Benefits filming brings to Downtown LA, both economic and intangible (national prestige, etc.)
 - ii) Report could already include considerations of DLANC stakeholders
 - d) **Arguments against CF:**
 - i) Potential impairment to construction/development of new housing
 - ii) Limited to no consideration of effect of filming on DLANC stakeholders
 - iii) Opportunity to report on permit enforcement in Downtown LA, including at City Council and Committee meetings
 - e) **Motion: Downtown Los Angeles Neighborhood Council (“DLANC”) should submit a Community Impact Statement opposing Council File 16-0245 unless the “report on the impact that various construction/development projects have on filming in the Downtown Los Angeles” area explicitly includes consideration of the effects filming has on Downtown Los Angeles residents, businesses and community members, including how to better enforce filming permits. The Community Impact Statement described above should be submitted in substantially the same form as that posted in support of this Agenda item.**
 - i) **DLANC authorizes Nate Johnson, chair of the Government Liaison Committee, to speak on its behalf pursuant to the Community Impact Statement described above at any City Council meeting or City department or committee meeting related to Council File 16-0245.**
 - ii) **DLANC further recommends that Mr. Johnson solicit community attendance and input in support of the Community Impact Statement described above for any City Council meeting or City department or committee meeting related to Council File 16-0245.**

- 2) **CIS “In Support Of”, CF 15-1138-S11** (Neighborhood Councils / Addressing Homelessness / Comprehensive Homeless Strategy)
- a) **CF Summary:**
 - i) File open May 3, 2016. City Clerk scheduled item for Council on October 11, 2016.
 - ii) The file moves the City Council to “instruct the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment to report on a process that would incorporate input from our Neighborhood Councils, including establishing a Homeless Advocate Program, as the City increases its investment in addressing homelessness.”
 - b) **GLC Action:** 9/21/2016 to recommend **Motion** below; Yea (6), Nay (0), Abstain (0)
 - c) **Arguments for CF:**
 - i) DLANC has unique interest in communicating concerns re: homelessness and Skid Row
 - ii) City could incorporate information and input from Neighborhood Councils, including DLANC
 - iii) Broad Neighborhood Council support (Los Feliz, LANCC, etc.)
 - iv) Council action at meeting on October 11, 2016, with opportunity for comment
 - d) **Arguments against CF:**
 - i) Unclear what process will actually be implemented, and whether it will yield results and better communications
 - e) **Motion: Downtown Los Angeles Neighborhood Council (“DLANC”) should submit a Community Impact Statement in support of Council File 15-1138-S11. The Community Impact Statement described above should be immediately submitted in substantially the same form as that posted in support of this Agenda item.**
 - i) **DLANC authorizes Nate Johnson, chair of the Government Liaison Committee, to speak on its behalf pursuant to the Community Impact Statement described above at any City Council meeting or City department or committee meeting related to Council File 16-0245. In the event Mr. Johnson is unable to attend a City Council meeting or City department or committee meeting related to Council File 16-0245, DLANC authorizes Mr. Johnson to appoint another member of DLANC to speak on its behalf pursuant to the Community Impact Statement described above.**
