We would like to see this continued and expanded throughout all of Downtown Los Angeles' neighborhood"; add concluding paragraph "Again, please consider adding/expanding permanent foot patrols, bike patrols, SPUs throughout Downtown Los Angeles' neighborhood".**

**Curnow moved to recommend to the DLANC board consideration of sending a letter of concern regarding safety in Downtown as amended. Boyce seconded. All voted in favor.**
