

The motion does not support Renew Executive Director Eduardo Santana's current communications to the Department of Recreation and Parks, CD14, and South West Community Engagement Communications and Outreach program leaders of the South West Grant stating that the Pershing Square Park Advisory Board supports the South West Grant with the Urban Space Kiosk Project attached to the Grant.

The motion being put forth by Executive Board of the Pershing Square Park Advisory Board to the full Pershing Square Park Advisory Board is stated as follows:

1. That the Pershing Square Park Advisory Board (PAB) cannot receive and or support funds from the South West Grant in its current state because it is attached to the Urban Space Kiosk project (Kiosks), which we do not support in its current presentation.
2. That the PAB rejects the Kiosk program because there is no feasibility or logistic report on how the installation of the Kiosks will effect:
  - A) Current programs established at Pershing Square
  - B) The power, plumbing, and use of facility of Pershing Square
  - C) Capital Improvements to Pershing Square necessary to facilitate the Kiosks
3. That there is no community study regarding the effects of the Kiosks on the community and surrounding businesses.
4. That there is no clear understanding what effect the Kiosks will have on current revenue coming into the park to cover salaries and program cost.
5. That there are no clear directions or agreements on how money will be charged for the Kiosks and how these funds will be dispensed and benefit Pershing Square.
6. That the Kiosks are not following City policy and procedure going out to a Request for Proposal or Concessions contract.
7. That the Kiosks may be using Pershing Square, a public facility, as a private concession.
